

ST. JOHN VIANNEY  
PARISH COUNCIL MEETING  
JUNE 24TH, 2004

Fr. Pat opened the meeting with a prayer.

Those present were Fr. Pat, Mary Lou Dietsch, Pat Mategrano, Tim Van Roy, Pat Riedmann, Bob Drewes, and John Wardian. Marilyn Olson and Pattie Money were excused.

The minutes of the May meeting were approved.

Magnetic name tags for the parish council were ordered.

Mary Lou and Tim have scheduled a meeting with the sign maker to continue work on the signage projects. The monument sign designated for the front lawn is being developed by BCDM. The cost will probably be around \$20,000. We hope to have it in place by the end of the year.

The Parish Festival will be September 19<sup>th</sup>. Mary Lou Dietsch, Tim Van Roy, and John Wardian volunteered to work the Spirit Booth. More volunteers are needed.

Bob Drewes reported the Athletic Committee had 40 golfers signed up for the August 21<sup>st</sup> Golf Tournament at Terra Hills starting at 9 AM. They are looking for prizes and have room for more golfers. Also, the committee is looking at initiating youth basketball this fall. They will meet in October to address this issue. Bob reported that initial contact with the league indicates that there will be an \$85 fee for each team. The goal is to have at least two 5<sup>th</sup> grade teams. League rules mandate that in order to play on a St. John Vianney team, players must be enrolled in the parish's religious ed program. A letter will be sent to the home of all eligible kids in mid-July.

There was no Marketing Committee report. Pat Riedmann will post the parish council meeting minutes on the web.

Tim reported the preliminary work on the capital campaign is progressing. A packet has been mailed to selected homes and soliciting teams are being formed.

Next year's goals were discussed. Mary Lou plans to have ministry representatives at next year's meetings to explain their ministries. Fr. Pat reported Marcia Potts will start on July 1<sup>st</sup> and part of her focus will be ministries. Mary Lou asked each council member to come up with a goal for next year that will help to improve our parish.

Tim is looking at setting up a program that will allow parishioners to make contributions or pay fees using credit or debit cards. The council discussed the idea and the general consensus was that the idea had merit. Tim will follow up on it going to talk to Security

The next meeting will be in September. As soon as the new schedule is completed, it will be mailed out to all members.

The meeting was closed with a prayer. A social hour followed the meeting.
