

ST. JOHN VIANNEY
PARISH COUNCIL MEETING
SEPTEMBER 28th, 2004

Tim Van Roy opened the meeting with a prayer due to Fr. Pat's absence at the beginning of the meeting.

Those present were Fr. Pat, Tim Van Roy, Mary Lou Dietsch, Pat Mategrano, Pat Riedmann, John Wardian, Patti Money, Tom Block, Kelly Korth, Val Shovanec. Bob Drewes was excused.

The June minutes were reviewed and approved.

One of the St. John Vianney APC delegates, Marilyn Pleskac, attended the meeting to give the council an overview of APC responsibilities and duties.

The council has been given name tags identifying each as a member. The name tags are to be worn during parish activities to increase parishioner awareness and give parishioners more access to council members.

One of the directional signs was posted on Oak Hills Country Club property. Although the parish asked and was given permission to place the sign, it was subsequently removed and returned to us. Kelly will contact the country club.

BCBM has been contacted to design a monumental sign for the front lawn of the parish. The initial estimate for the labor and materials is approximately \$20,000. No work is being planned at this time.

A general discussion was held informing the council of the progress of the capital campaign.

The council was informed of the upcoming ministry fair and their expected participation. Tim has designed a brochure and John volunteered to design a poster. Council members volunteered to man the parish council booth after each of the masses.

The council members agreed to post the monthly meeting minutes in the narthex and on the web.

The council members each stated personal goals for the upcoming year. Mary Lou has a list of these goals and we will review this list at a (not yet specified) later date to ensure the goals are being met.

Pat reported the Marketing Committee hasn't met since the last council meeting.

Val reported the Spiritual Growth committee will be working on adult education opportunities. Fr. Pat reported that work has begun on an advent series and speakers have been lined up.

Fr. Pat reported (Finance Committee) that the construction contracts are ready to be signed off. This needs to be done before we can apply to the International Knights of Columbus for a more permanent loan.

Tim reported that work is being done to buy a volleyball system. There have not been a lot of sign-ups for youth basketball.

There is a need for more paper towel holders/disposal units in the men's and women's restrooms. Fr. Pat asked Tim to work with the parish property manager to see if it would be feasible to have more units installed.

Fr. Pat reported that a volunteer/ministry appreciation dinner is being planned.

The next meeting is scheduled for Oct. 26th.
